August 6, 2009 4:00 PM, Lillooet Emergency Operations Centre

- There will be a bus at McArthur Island at noon on Friday, August 7, 2009 to transport any residents that missed transportation to Lillooet. This will be the last chance for anyone evacuated from Lillooet to return on provided transportation.

The Evacuation Alert for all areas of Cayoose, T'it'q'et, Bridge River and the District of Lillooet remain in effect.

- Evacuation Orders may need to be reissued; if that is deemed necessary the evacuation process will recommence.
- The rehabilitation of Lillooet has proceeded smoothly and the RCMP has taken down many of their check points.
- Those evacuated by Interior Health Authority will be notified directly regarding transfer back to the community. Home Support clients should contact Interior Health at 250-256-1313.
- The handout provided to residents upon entering the community is available at the District office.
- As instructed from Interior Health a boil water advisory is in effect for all areas of the District of Lillooet and T'it'q'et. This is to protect the residents while we have our water tested.
- On Friday, August 7, 2009, the Emergency Operation Centre will return to the Lillooet Municipal Hall at 615 Main Street.
